## WHAT IS A THEME IN WORDPRESS?

- ▶ A theme defines the look and feel of the pages and posts in your website.
- ▶ It provides locations for a header, menus, widgets, a content area and a footer.
- ▶ It provides styling options available through the customizer or theme options settings in the dashboard.
- ▶ It may bring in additional plugin like functionality. For example a photography theme may have a photo gallery built in.

## WORDPRESS PAGES

- ▶ Pages - Static part of your website. They may have a hierarchy. Used by to build an SEO friendly slug. Pages may have theme specific templates for different layouts.
- ▶ Posts - blog section of your website. Posts are organized by categories, and have tags for search engines. Posts can have featured images and these are treated differently depending on the theme.
- ▶ Archive pages (blog pages) - a WP generated page with several posts. Layout differs greatly based on the theme.

## PICKING A THEME CAN BE TRICKY

- ▶ Themes look different from their mock up pages.
- ▶ Some features may be only available in the Pro version
- ▶ You'll need to add some content before you get a feeling for how the theme will work for your needs
- ▶ In particular you need several pages and a half dozen posts plus some header or gallery photos (or drawings) to build a mock up.
- ▶ You may need to build some dummy pages for a menu structure
- ▶ You'll need to explore theme options.
